This permit is being issued to you for the purpose of fun and recreation. Please do not violate this permit by using it to burn leaves and tree limbs to clear the property.

307.3 The location for open burning shall not be less than 50 feet from any structure, and provisions shall be made to prevent the fire from spreading to within 50 feet of any structure.

Exceptions:

- 1. Fires in approved containers that are not less than 15 feet from a structure
- 2. The minimum required distance from a structure shall be 25 feet where the pile size is 3 feet or less in diameter and 2 feet or less in height.

307.3.1 A bonfire shall not be conducted within 50 feet of a structure or combustible material unless the fire is contained in a barbecue pit. Conditions which could cause a fire to spread within 50 feet of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition.

307.3.2 Recreation fires shall not be conducted within 25 feet of a structure of combustible material. Conditions which could cause a fire to spread within 25 feet of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition.

307.4 Open burning; bonfires or recreational fire shall be constantly attended until the fire is extinguished. At minimum, a portable fire extinguisher or other approved on-site fire-extinguishing equipment, such as dirt, sand, water barrel, garden hose or water truck, shall be available for immediate utilization.
