### Facilities

#### What to Expect

##### Entering the Aquatics Center

- Members only permitted at this time; no guests.
- All members must be screened before entering the facility; including a temperature scan.
- Masks or face coverings are recommended but not required upon entering as well as inside the facility.
- Members will be asked to sign a login book that establishes information for potential contact tracing.
- Aquatics Center hours will be 10:30am to 8:00pm.
- The aquatics center is limited to no more than 80 members at a time.
- Members will be limited to 2 hour time slots to use the pool beginning when the facility opens each day. Each two hour slot will be followed by a 30 minute closure to clean the facility and prepare for the next group of members.
- Reserving time slots can be done one of three ways:

  - Calling our front desk at 563-2895
  - In person at the front door
    - Members registering at the door will only be permitted inside if the real-time schedule has an open slot.
- Members must be 14 years of age or older to enter the aquatics center without an adult.
- Open swim will be in effect during the two hour time slot except the final 15 minutes, which will be reserved for adult swim.
- The facility has been set up for social distancing by installing signage to help you enter and exit safely.
- Seating has been spread out through the entire facility to allow for social distancing. We ask that chairs not be moved and that members observe the 6' distancing with anyone outside their household both in the pool or on the deck.
- Pool staff will not police social distancing.
- Water fountains have been disabled. Please bring your own water bottle.
- Pool locker rooms are currently closed. Please arrive ready to swim. Two individual restrooms will be open.
- All pools are open including comp, plunge, and family.
- The diving boards and large slide structure will be closed to allow for more swimmers at this time.
- The concession stand will be open with a limited menu. All HCPH guidelines will be in place.
- Sharks swim team, Splash aerobics classes, all aquatic events, birthday parties, and group swim lessons will not take place this summer. Private lessons will be offered outside of operating hours.

#### Reminders

##### Entering the Aquatics

- If you feel ill, stay home.
- Bring membership cards for all swimmers. Guests are not permitted at this time.
- Arrive ready to swim.
- Bring your own water bottle and snacks.
- No alcohol allowed. Please remember that coolers will be checked.
- Don't expect to shower in the locker rooms as they will be closed.
- Remember to take all items with you. Our lost and founds have been eliminated and we will dispose of all items left in the building.
- Keep 6 feet of space between you and others.
- Sharing goggles, pool toys, etc is prohibited.
- In an effort to allow everyone a fair chance at visiting the facility, members can register for one 2-hour spot for the entire week (Monday-Sunday) beginning on Monday & Tuesday of the previous week. Starting on Wednesday of that previous week, members will be allowed to register for any remaining time slots still available for the entire following week (Monday-Sunday). Members are limited to one time slot per day. We appreciate your honesty and patience with this new process.

### Keeping Clean

#### What to Expect

##### Sanitization

- Practice good hygiene before, during, and after leaving the facility.
- Hand sanitizing stations have been setup in the facility. Our hand sanitization products have met CDC guidelines.
- Two individual restrooms will be open.
- Restrooms and public areas are being disinfected every two hours using EPA-registered disinfectants, particularly on high-touch surfaces such as faucets, toilets, doorknobs and light switches.
- Locker rooms will not be available at this time. Please arrive ready to swim.
- Common surfaces such as hand rails, pool furniture, and concession tables & chairs will be cleaning during our 30 minute closures.

#### Reminders

##### Sanitization

- Be sure to sanitize your hands frequently while in the facility.
- Gloves are not recommended as our facility will have ample sanitizer which is the CDC's best practice for keeping your hands clean.
- Do not touch your face or eyes.
- Cover your coughs or sneezes.
- Chairs will be cleaned during closures but not while the facility is open. Members are encouraged to bring cleaning wipes should they need to clean their chairs.

### Pool Staff

##### Staff

- Pool staff will screened every day before entering the facility. You will see pool staff wearing PPE.
- Pool staff will not police social distancing.
- We respectfully ask that you maintain social distance between other members and the pool staff.
