### Facilities

#### What to Expect

##### Entering the Building

- Members only permitted at this time; no guests.
- All members must be screened before entering the building; including a temperature scan.
- Masks or face coverings are recommended but not required upon entering as well as inside the building.
- Members will be asked to sign a login book that establishes information for potential contact tracing.
- The facility has been set up for social distancing by installing barriers and signage to help you enter and exit safely.
- Excess seating has been removed throughout the building. Members are asked to exit after their activity has concluded.
- Water fountains have been disabled. Only the no touch bottle filler is permitted. Please bring your own water or water bottle.
- Vending machines have been disabled.

#### Reminders

##### Entering the Building

- If you feel ill, stay home.
- Bring your membership card.
- Arrive ready for your activity.
- Bring only essential items into the building with you (wallet, keys, phone, devices). If it cannot fit in a gallon zip lock bag, it should stay in your car.
- Bring your own water bottle.
- Remember to take all items with you. Our lost and finds have been eliminated and we will dispose of all items left in the building.
- Keep 6 feet of space between you and others.

### Keeping Clean

##### Sanitization

- Practice good hygiene before, during, and after leaving the facility.
- Hand sanitizing stations have been setup throughout the building. Our hand sanitization products have met CDC guidelines.
- Restrooms are open and foot pedals have been installed for no touch entrance/exit. The number of users at one time in the restroom will be limited to 2.
- Locker rooms will not be available at this time. Please arrive ready for your activity.
- Restrooms and public areas are being disinfected every two hours using EPA-registered disinfectants, particularly on high-touch surfaces such as faucets, toilets, doorknobs and light switches.

##### Sanitization

- Be sure to sanitize your hands frequently while in the facility.
- Gloves are not recommended as our facility will have ample sanitizer which is the CDC's best practice for keeping your hands clean.
- Do not touch your face or eyes.
- Cover your coughs or sneezes.

### Rec Staff

##### Our Staff

- Rec staff will be screened every day before entering the building. You will see our staff wearing PPE and constantly cleaning.
- We respectfully ask that you maintain social distance between other members and our staff.
