What to Expect

Using the Nursery

- The nursery is limited to no more than 6 children at a time. Children must be members, no guests.
- Member visits to the nursery are limited to 1 hour time slots. Each one hour slot will be followed by a 15 minute closure to clean.
- Reserving time slots can be done one of three ways:
 - Online at www.supersaas.com/schedule/sharonvillerec
 - Calling our front desk at 563-2895
 - In person at the front door
 - Members registering at the door will only be permitted inside if the real-time schedule has an open slot.
- Parents will be met at nursery door for drop off and pickup of children.
- Nursery staff will not assist with toileting or diapering at this time. If bathroom breaks are needed, parents will be called.
- Stations will be setup to facilitate social distancing as best as possible.
- Toys, books, etc will be limited to allow for cleaning.
- Nursery hours will vary slightly with new schedule.
- Nursery patio and play structure will not be open.

Keeping Clean

Sanitization

- Children should use restroom and wash hands before entering the nursery. Hands will be washed when leaving as well.
- No eating or drinking will be allowed in the nursery. Additionally personal pacifiers, blankets, and stuffed animals will not be permitted.
- After children use toys they will be placed in bins and taken to another area for cleaning and disinfecting, before a new group of children enter the facility.
- Cleaning and disinfecting will be consistent with ODJFS and CDC standards and best practices.

Rec Staff

Our Staff

- Rec staff will screened every day before entering the building. You will see our staff wearing PPE and constantly cleaning.

Reminders

Using the Nursery

- If you feel ill, stay home.
- Bring your membership card.
- All members must be screened before entering the building; including a temperature scan.
- Masks or face coverings are recommended but not required upon entering as well as inside the building.
- Arrive ready for your activity.
- Bring only essential items into the building with you (wallet, keys, phone, devices). If it cannot fit in a gallon zip lock bag, it should stay in your car.
- Bring your own water bottle.
- Remember to take all items with you. Our lost and founds have been eliminated and we will dispose of all items left in the building.
- Keep 6 feet of space between you and others.

Sanitization

- Be sure to sanitize your hands frequently while in the facility.
- Gloves are not recommended as our facility will have ample sanitizer which is the CDC's best practice for keeping your hands clean.
- Do not touch your face or eyes.
- Cover your coughs or sneezes.
