Just Announced! 2nd Round of Small Business Relief Grant

Utilizing CARES Act funding, the City of Sharonville developed the Small Business Relief Program to assist companies with expenses directly resulting from business interruption or arising from the decrease in gross revenue in connection with the COVID-19 pandemic. Businesses are eligible to have expenses such as rent/mortgage, utilities, equipment purchase to encourage social distancing and personal protective equipment covered in increments of \$2,500, \$5,000, \$7,500 or \$10,000.

This round it is open to businesses with 50 or fewer employees and sole proprietors. Applicants have until April 1st to apply.

Updates at Gower Park

New ADA compliant playground equipment will be installed at Gower Park. This project will include the addition of three new pieces of playground equipment that will be fun for children of all abilities. The equipment will be located centrally in the playground with easy access via poured in place surfacing and entrance. The three pieces are a We Go Round, We Saw, and Cozy Dome. The anticipated completion date is by June 2021.



The Gower swing replacement project is still a work in progress, but our hope is to run this project alongside the construction occurring with the ADA equipment. This could be completed by June 2021 as well. All of the old swing bays at Gower playground will be replaced with new swings and new options, similar to the popular 2 person swing installed at Gorman Park last year. At this time photos of the swings are concepts and may change as the project moves forward.
