SORTA's Transit Infrastructure Fund program has awarded Sharonville to assist in paying 70% of the cost to repave the Kemper Road multi-use path from US 42 west. Improvements at several crosswalks will be done as well to provide improved access to the existing Metro Bus stop locations.
