ATTENTION! Our code was recently updated regarding high grass and weeds. One of the most frequent complaints the city receives during spring and summer months is about high grass and weeds, particularly for those repeat offenders. Effective as of January of this year, property owners will be mailed only ONE written notice regarding high grass and weeds. Subsequent notices will be placed on the front door but will not be sent via mail for repeat violations.

As before, if the property remains non-compliant after notice, the city will mow the offending property with the cost billed directly to the property owner. The length of grass (8" or more) remains unchanged to be considered a nuisance.
