## Connectivity Priorities

Connectivity was a popular theme identified in our Sharonville 2030 Comprehensive Plan. That feedback is being put into action.

### 2024 Projects

- US-42 Shared Use Path: Beginning this month, work will begin on a multi-use path from our Downtown Loop up Lebanon Road to Kemper Road.
- Kemper Road Multi-Use Path: The existing path from Lebanon Road west will be replaced. In addition, improvements at several crosswalks will be done to provide improved access to existing Metro Bus stop locations.

### Future Projects

- Downtown Loop: The second phase of the Streetscape project will focus on Reading Road and begin in latter part of 2025. As part of this phase, the sidewalks will be replaced.
- Cornell Road: We are actively pursuing creative strategies to add sidewalks to portions of the road and apply for funding. Stay tuned!



### Completed Projects

- 2023 – Sidewalks were added to Hauck Road as part of the road widening project.
- 2022 – Sidewalks were added from UDF to the Sharon Woods Kemper entrance.

## Gorman Park Ribbon Cutting

Just two years after we opened the Gorman Park Splash Pad we are ready to debut the completed second phase of the park to the public. Join us Wednesday, May 22nd at 5 PM at Gorman Park for our ribbon cutting ceremony!
