

Curbside Brush & Special Pickup

This service is freely offered year-round to **residents**. To schedule, please call 513-563-1177 before 5:00 pm on Friday to have the address added to the pickup-list for the following week. Everything is to be set out Sunday night. Brush (limbs/ branches under 8" in dia.) must be stacked going in the same direction, with root balls removed, and placed with ends facing the road. Root balls and stumps **CANNOT** go in the chipper and therefore, must be separated. If debris contains more than limbs, please mention that when calling.

*****Twigs are considered yard waste and are to be disposed with regular garbage.*****

Construction / building materials can also be picked up provided you specify what you have when scheduling. Such items include: cabinets, sinks, tubs, toilets, vinyl / wood flooring, lumber and fencing. Any tile **MUST** be in buckets and not exceed **50 lbs**.

Each pick up is limited to 15 minutes. If more time is needed, you may rent a city truck overnight to load items yourself. The costs are as follows:

- Residential - \$50 – during the week
- Residential - \$60 – for a weekend (dropped off on Friday, picked up Monday)
- Business - \$90 – regardless of day of the week

*****Please note: This service is offered from mid-April thru the end of October. Scheduling begins April 1st for the middle of April.*****

Trash Collection Reminders

Appliances (refrigerators, freezers, etc.) containing chlorofluorocarbon (CFC) refrigerants **MUST** have the CFC removed by a certified technician with approved documentation. In addition, Rumpke requires a Refrigerant Recovery Statement form – available at www.Rumpke.com. Without **BOTH**, Rumpke **WILL NOT** pick it up.

Mattresses and box springs or any upholstered furniture **MUST** be completely wrapped in plastic and sealed tightly with tape in order for Rumpke to dispose of the item. Notify Rumpke of large items to be picked up a day in advance by calling 513-851-0122.

The following items **CANNOT** be placed at the curb for trash collection: computers, televisions, fluorescent bulbs, and hazardous waste. Homeowners can contact the Hamilton County and Butler County Recycling and Solid Waste Districts for help disposing of electronics and hazardous waste.
