



Heard The Spotted Lanternfly (SLF) is making its rounds around Ohio and Hamilton County? It's an invasive insect that's been identified in multiple Ohio Counties.

What to Do if You Spot SLF:

- 📷 Take a picture: capture a clear photo of the insect, regardless of its life stage.
- 📄 Submit: Upload the photo to the [Ohio Department of Agriculture](https://bit.ly/3wfWB9m) for proper identification — <https://bit.ly/3wfWB9m>.
- 👊 Then stomp it and squash it!

Some things you can do to help manage SLF include scrapping egg masses; use sticky bands to trap, collect and then dispose of SLF; insecticide treatment; and mechanical removal of the tree of heaven (a favorite host of SLF).


