Veteran Banner Program

Our Veteran Street Banner Program began in 2024. Veteran banners were recently hung around our Downtown Loop for the second year of the 2-year cycle. They will remain up until approximately a week after Veterans Day. They will be hung once again in the new year dependent on weather conditions. They will remain hanging until April. At that time, banners will be retired to the applicants.
